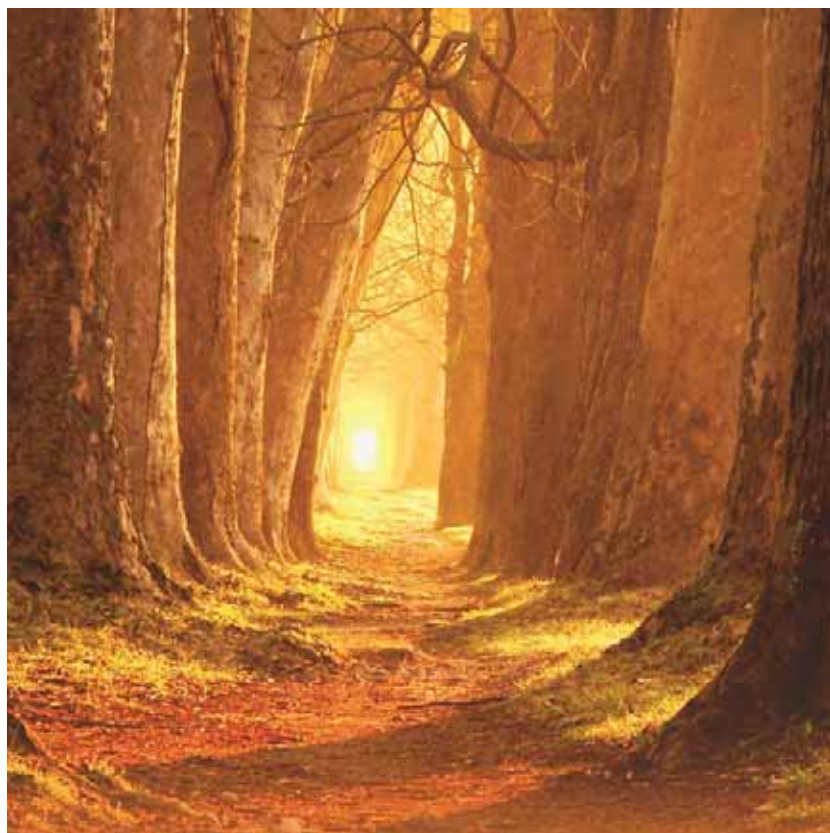

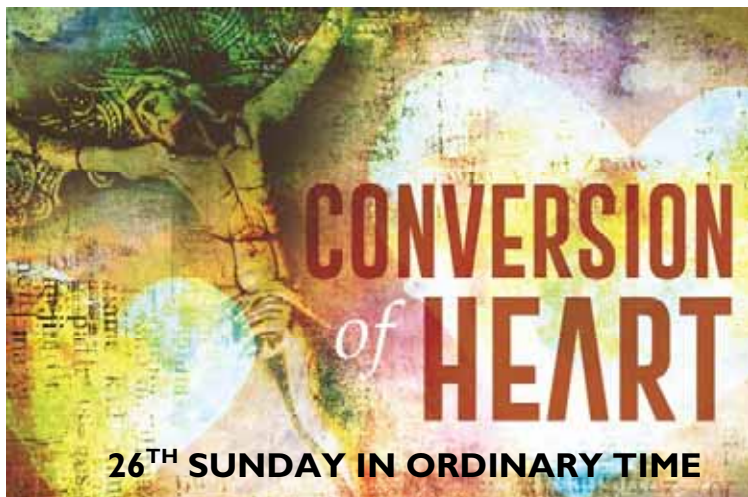

Amen, I say to you, tax collectors and prostitutes are entering the kingdom of God before you. Ouch. This had to sting. Jesus spoke these shocking words not just to anybody. He spoke them to the chief priests and elders of the people. The ones who were professional law-keepers. The ones who were religious leaders and teachers. The ones who were, in truth, self-righteous, pompous, and presumptuous. Jesus must have known how offensive it would be to his audience to share this unpleasant fact. But he said it anyway because he knew they needed to hear it.

But the point wasn't to offend. The point was to amend. Jesus was urging them to change their lives for the better, to come to God with a humble, contrite heart, seeking forgiveness and mercy. These unrepentant upper-crust leaders were plagued by an inability to see their own sins. They were far too focused on identifying where others were going wrong. And, as was his style, Jesus' preaching was adapted according to his audience. These guys needed to get knocked out of their complacency. So Jesus did what he had to do.

It's important to realize, by the way, that the reason tax collectors and prostitutes were leading the line to heaven wasn't because of their sins. It was because of their sorrow. The people Jesus had in mind when he mentioned this--like Zacchaeus and Mary Magdalene perhaps--had repented from their sinful behavior and begun anew. This is why he praises them. This is what the Lord longs to see everyone doing, including us. Either we need to acknowledge and repent of our sins, or we are placing ourselves in the same category as the pharisaical priests and elders. And that's definitely not the place to be.

26. NEDJELJA KROZ GODINU

Motiv dvojice braće i njihove različite reakcije predstavlja srž današnje evanđeoske poruke. U mnogim biblijskim zgoda- ma nalazimo motiv dvojice braće. Prisjeti- mo se nekih: Kain koji ubija svoga brata Abela; Jakov preotima bratu Ezavu pravo na nasljedstvo i na prijevaru dobiva očev blagoslov; dvojica braće iz prisposode o milosrdnom Ocu... U Isusovoj priči riječ je o čovjeku koji je imao dva sina i šalje ih na posao u vinograd. Prvi ocu odgovara: *Ne- ću!* No poslije se predomisli i ode. Drugi od- govori: *Evo me!* i ne ode. U prisjećanju na djetinjstvo mnogi prepoznaju obrazac po- našanja dvojice sinova iz evanđelja: jedno dijete koje je poslušno i roditeljima uvijek odgovara 'da'; i drugo dijete koje je bun- tovno, prkosno, i odmah kaže 'ne'.

Ako pokušamo ovu evanđeosku zgo- du vidjeti iz dubinsko-psihološkoga motriš- ta, tada dvojica sinova mogu predstavljati različite aspekte vlastitoga duševnog živo- ta, odnosno, upućuju na različite osjećaje i mogućnosti ponašanja u nama samima. Tako otkrivamo da zapravo obojicu braće nosimo u sebi: kako onoga koji pristojno kaže 'da', ali iza čijih riječi ne slijede djela; tako i onoga drugoga koji zlovoljno kaže 'ne', ali nakon što se malo pribrao i razmis- lio, ipak je poslušao svoga oca. Često u se- bi nosimo 'dvije duše': u nama se bore lice- mjer i buntovnik. Ovaj obrazac – 'lijepa pri- ča' ili 'djelotvorna i energična akcija' – pri- sutan je u mnogim područjima ljudske dje- latnosti. Iz Isusovih je riječi sasvim razvid- no da je Bogu draži onaj koji možda kaže da ne vjeruje a ipak čini dobro, od onoga koji se bučno kune u svoju vjeru a u živo- noj praksi prezire ljubav i dobrotu. Često je veoma dug put koji vodi od 'reći ne' pa do toga da se osoba 'predomisli' i na koncu is- puni volju očevu.
