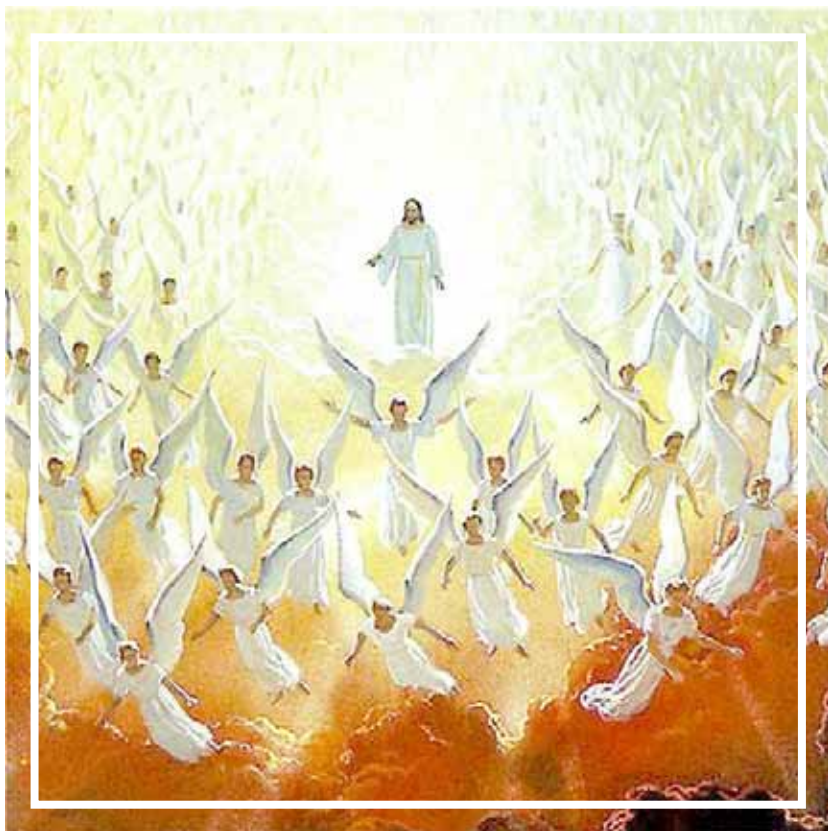

THE END OF THE WORLD

33rd SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Lately, the end of the world is one of the most common topics among people. Everyone is wondering how it will be when the world comes to an end. Different religious groups offer different scenarios. Some sects claim that they are the only group chosen to lead humankind toward some new civilization. Their beliefs are based on various private revelations of people claiming to be worthy of some miraculous divine knowledge. On the other hand, the Lord tells us today that no one knows about *that day and hour, even the angels in heaven, not the Son, but only the Father. It seems that Jesus wants to make our understanding of the end of the world even more dramatic. And He is right. As long as we do not understand that the end of the world happens in each one of those moments when we choose God or reject Him we will continue to be far away from a true understanding of life. We are called to understand and take serious Jesus' message about the end of the world and live every day as the day when we will meet God face to face.*
